

Preventive Resin Restoration: Dr Scott Townsend

A preventive resin restoration is a thin resin coating placed on the chewing surface of molars, premolars and any deep grooves called pits.

These restorations are recommended when there are stains or deep grooves in the pits of teeth

They are intended to help prevent the need for fillings down the road - but do not guarantee a cavity will not develop. It's important to floss and brush and have routine care & dental exams to maintain healthy teeth.

The grooves and pits of these teeth are cleaned out to remove any small amounts of decay that is in the enamel and dentin.

This procedure is performed without any dental freezing.
